

Stable Rules

Warning, all riding and handling is done at your own risk.

Hillside Basic Rules

- Tobacco, Alcohol or smoking of any kind is not permitted on property.
- Any visitors to Hillside are also expected to follow all rules.
- Any person on property must have a signed release of liability form on file.
- Host of visitors is responsible to inform them of stable rules.
- All trash or other waste is to be disposed of into a trash bin.
- All persons on property are required to clean up after themselves.
- No person is to enter the house on property without direct permission from family.
- Be respectful of others personal property.
- Any unnecessary reprimanding of any kind to a horse will not be tolerated.
- Dogs are welcomed at Hillside, but must be on a leash and under control of owner at all times.
- Help your fellow riders and boarders. Always try to work together, and resolve problems quickly and only between the people who are included in the issue.
- Please do not give treats to horses other than your own, unless approved by the owner.
- Feeding of horses is to only be performed by Hillside staff.
- Practice safe riding principles and good barn etiquette.
- Have fun and stay safe!

Pasture Rules

- We advise that halters be removed from horses when turned out. If halters must be left on, breakaways will be required.
- Do not leave any gates open without the permission of stable owner.

Barn Rules

- No Horse is to be left unattended when tied in its stall or on crossties.
- Do not block doors or hallways.
- All horses must be washed in designated washing areas.
- Water hoses should be recoiled and faucets turned off when finished.
- Boarders are required to check with stable owner before making stall, pasture or tack room changes.
